



Symposium on `Integrating New Advances in Mediterranean Oceanography and Marine Biology`

The symposium on <u>Integrating New Advances in Mediterranean Oceanography and Marine Biology</u> aims to address recent scientific advances in marine science in the Mediterranean, from a cross-boundary perspective and looking towards future changes. It will take place between 26-29 November 2013 in Barcelona, Spain

All sessions will be held in plenary to facilitate cross-disciplinarity. They will consist of invited talks and contributed presentations and posters, and time for discussion. Registration opens on 15 July 2013 and abstract submission deadline is 30 September 2013. The symposium is cosponsored by the SOLAS endorsed project ADEPT.

- The North Pacific Research Board announced the launch of a new Long-Term Monitoring Program aimed at supporting new or existing time-series research that will enhance our ability to understand the current state of the marine ecosystem and support efforts to predict future ecosystem states in response to changing ocean conditions.

NPRB is seeking pre-proposals with a submission deadline of 4pm, Monday, July 15, 2013.

- Eleven working group proposals that have been submitted to the SCOR Secretariat for consideration at the 2013 SCOR Executive Meeting are available on the <u>SCOR Web</u> <u>site</u>. SCOR Executive Committee is grateful for comments from SCOR National Committees, individuals, and interested organizations to assist in the review of these proposals.
- The intergovernmental funding programme COST has a continuous open call for networking activities. COST is funding networking activities such as meetings, conferences, short-term scientific exchanges, trainings and outreach activities. COST does not fund research itself.
- The German research vessel SONNE will be used to carry out a Training and Capacity Building Cruise in the framework of SPACES in the waters around Southern Africa and the Indian Ocean during 22. June 21. July 2014. The co-ordinators of this project, at the GEOMAR Helmholtz Centre for Ocean Research Kiel and Namibia, invite up to 26 young scientists and students from Germany, Namibia and other countries in southern Africa to take part in one of the two legs of this cruise.
