SOLAS workshops in 2016

- The first workshop will focus on `Concurrent remote-sensing inversions of ocean and atmosphere: new science and new opportunities` to be held 13-16 June 2016 at ESRIN the headquarters for ESA's Earth Observation activities in Frascati, Italy. This joined SOLAS/ESA workshop will allow participants to share their experiences conducting remote sensing studies of the ocean and atmosphere.
- The second workshop on `SOLAS science and society` will take place 26-27 October 2016 in Brussels, Belgium. The aim of this workshop will be to bring together both natural and social scientists as an outcome of a discussion session at the SOLAS Open Science Conference 2015 (report available here).
