DMS climatology released

A new global monthly climatology of dimethylsulfide (DMS) concentrations in the surface ocean, named L10, is now freely available for download here. L10 consists of 12 monthly maps with a resolution of 1°x1° and is reported in a recent article in Global Biogeochemical Cycles available here.

This is the result of a collaborative effort between SOLAS Project Integration (Tom Bell and Peter Liss based at the <u>UEA</u>, Norwich) and the <u>ICM-CSIC</u> (Arancha Lana and Rafel Simó, Barcelona), with funding provided by the EU through <u>COST Action 735</u>, <u>EUROCEANS</u>, and the Spanish <u>MICINN</u>.
